

HAM-CHEESE CRUNCH SANDWICH

Linda Shane's



8 slices white bread
Butter or margarine, softened
Prepared mustard
4 slices boiled ham
4 slices American cheese
1 tomato, thinly sliced
2 slightly beaten eggs
2 tablespoons milk
Dash onion salt
1 $\frac{1}{4}$ cups crushed potato chips

Spread each slice of bread on one side with butter or margarine, then mustard. Top 4 slices of bread with ham, cheese and tomato slices, then with remaining bread.

Combine eggs, milk, and onion salt. Dip sandwiches into egg mixture, then into crushed potato chips, patting to secure chips to bread, and turning to coat both sides. Do not coat the edges of the sandwiches; just the top and bottom of the sandwich,

Brown on both sides in buttered skillet or griddle till crisp, about 8 minutes. Serve hot. Makes 4 servings.
