



BAKED POTATOES IN A HURRY - Insert a nail to shorten the baking time by 15 minutes.

BAKING - For baking it's best to use medium to large eggs. Extra large eggs may cause cakes to fall when cooled.

COPPER POTS - Dip lemon halves in salt and rub to clean or rub with Worcestershire sauce or catsup. The tarnish will disappear.

POULTRY - After flouring chicken, chill for one hour. The coating adheres better before frying.

LONGER LASTING PANTY HOSE - Before you ever wear a pair of hose they should be frozen first. They will last longer if you wet them thoroughly, ring out gently, place in a plastic bag and toss in the freezer. Once frozen, thaw in bathtub and then hang to dry. Or starch them very, very lightly. This helps resist runs and they will also go on easily.

CHEWING GUM - Place garment in plastic bag and put in freezer. Scrape off frozen gum.

THERE'S A BEE IN THE HOUSE - If a wasp or bee gets into the house, reach for the hairspray. Most insect sprays only infuriate them, but the hairspray stiffens their wings, immobilizing them immediately. This works well on any winged insect.

CLEANING TENNIS SHOES - Use rubbing alcohol. This also makes shoe polish go on easier and last longer.

HOUSEPLANTS - Give your plant a shot of Geritol on a regular basis for three months. Within a month you will notice new leaves have begun to appear.

CLEAR PLASTIC WRAP - Keep clear plastic wrap in the refrigerator to prevent it from sticking together.
