

Pineapple Lime Cheesecake Pie

The pineapple is a symbol of welcome and hospitality.

Legend says sea captains would return from a voyage and bring pineapples and other exotic fruits home. The captain would display a pineapple speared on his fence, a sign he had returned.

The pineapple was a symbol of hospitality and welcomed neighbors and friends to visit and hear tales of the high seas.

Today, the pineapple continues to be the symbol of hospitality!

- 1 reduced calorie graham cracker crust
- 1 20 oz can of pineapple, packed in its own juice
- 1 lime
- 1 tub of lite whipped topping
- 1 box of Jell-O cheesecake pudding
- 1/2 C. of flaked coconut

Squeeze the juice from one lime into a large mixing bowl. Add pineapple, juice and all. Quickly stir or whisk in the contents of the box of cheesecake pudding and coconut. Fold in tub of whipped topping and pile into cracker crust. I add one cherry to the top and arrange several thin lime slices around on the top.
